ADDITIONAL MANDATORY FEES

Application Fee (New Students):

• \$150 non-refundable application fee per student, paid online when submitting initial application.

Registration/Enrollment Fee (New Students):

If offered admission to Berean Christian (BCHS), a non-refundable registration fee must be submitted when confirming enrollment:

- \$575 per student for seniors
- \$525 per student for non-seniors

The emailed admissions offer letter will describe how to complete the online FACTS enrollment process, during which the non-refundable registration fee will be collected.

Registration/Re-Enrollment Fee (Returning Students):

On or before 2/28/26

- \$575 per student for seniors
- \$525 per student for non-seniors

After 2/28/26

- \$675 per student for seniors
- \$625 per student for non-seniors

The non-refundable registration/re-enrollment fee will be collected as part of the FACTS online re-enrollment process, payable via electronic check or credit/debit card. If the re-enrollment process is not completed by February 28, 2026, we cannot guarantee your student's space for next year. Beginning March 1, 2026, enrollment will be open for new student applicants.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

In addition to the tuition and mandatory fees described above, students will incur additional fees depending on their class, activity, and transportation selections. The most common fees are described in the following pages. Upon evaluation, new offerings not listed below may also be assessed fees.

Dual-Credit Fees

Berean Christian offers selected courses approved by cooperating colleges with the option for students to earn dual high school and college credit. Students desiring to earn the college credit in such courses will be subject to additional tuition due the accrediting college, typically \$300-\$600 per course. For most courses, the family will submit the additional fee directly to the college.

P.E. Clothing and Locks

These items are purchased by incoming students and may be used throughout the student's tenure at BCHS:

- Locks \$25 (Students will keep their locks during the summer. If a student loses the lock, a replacement for \$25 can be
 purchased at Registration or in the front office.)
- P.E. Clothes For students enrolled in P.E. or weights class, use of BCHS P.E. shorts and shirt are required. Students
 needing these items will be sent information in the summer with purchase options. (Optional: sweatpants, sweatshirt,
 and/or additional shorts and shirts available)

Yearbooks

BCHS automatically bills all students for a yearbook in the fall; however, yearbooks remain optional and yearbook charge (typically \$80 to \$100) can be reversed upon following the "opt out" instructions provided at the time of billing.

Athletic Fees

Charged to all students participating in interscholastic sports in a given school year:

• All sports = \$395 per student per sport

Notes:

- Although uniforms, basic equipment, officiating, coach training, league dues, and facilities are covered by the above base fee for most sports, most teams require additional items to be purchased (e.g. footwear, warm-ups, swimsuits, snacks & hydration, team auction basket donation, other gear) which will result in account charges and/or out-of-pocket expenses IN ADDITION TO the sports fee above. For some sports, costs beyond the base fee can be substantial (up to several hundred dollars); parents are responsible to read all correspondence and attend team informational meetings to learn the full financial commitment required for participating in a particular sport. Some teams offer (or require) fundraising to help offset these additional fees.
- 2) The base sports fee above will not be charged for students who choose to withdraw from the team within 2 weeks from start of their participation, although any charges for personalized gear or supplies ordered on behalf of the student will remain due. Students leaving the team after 2 weeks participation will still be responsible for the full sports fee and any additional charges, as will students joining the team mid-season.

Transportation Expenses

- Students who drive to BCHS must purchase an annual parking pass (\$25).
- Berean Christian offers bus transportation to and from school from selected locations in Contra Costa County. Student
 accounts are billed monthly in arrears per one-way trip, with the fee per ride depending upon bus stop location used
 (e.g. varying from \$3.00 per one-way trip to/from Walnut Creek to \$6.00 per one-way trip to/from Brentwood in recent

years). Fees and routes are subject to change based on demand and fuel costs. For information on current routes, stops, and fees, click on the Bus Application & Routes link under the Student Life menu at www.bereanchristian.com.

Other Potential Fees

TBD - exact amounts will vary from year to year. Parents are responsible to read all Berean Christian correspondence and attend informational meetings to be informed of full financial commitments required for various activities, clubs, and performance groups. Amounts shown are the typical range for recent years:

- Advanced Drama and Stagecraft mandatory tour & t-shirt/sweatshirt: \$550-\$600
- Advanced Choir mandatory tour: \$500-\$600
- Performance clothing for Advanced Choir and Chorale: \$75-100
- Cheerleading and Dance: \$1,000-\$1,500/year for uniforms and accessories, travel fees, competition fees, camps, etc.
- Shakespearean Literature class mandatory plays and festival trip: \$300-\$450
- Club dues and gear (e.g. Model UN Conference Fees: \$75-\$100; Robotics Club: \$200-\$300)
- Late AP exams: \$25 per each ½ hour of exam proctoring

Other Miscellaneous Expenses

Field trips, admissions to athletic, drama, and music events, banquets and socials, yearbook senior tributes, lunches, school photo purchase, school spirit wear, standardized test prep & college essay workshops, Summer Biology program, detention and Saturday School fines, club apparel and functions, fundraisers, etc.

PART-TIME ENROLLMENT & OFF-CAMPUS CLASSES

Part-time Berean Christian enrollment is only permitted on a case-by-case basis and is not encouraged. Seniors must obtain pre-approval from the BCHS Director of Academics to be granted part-time status, defined as enrollment in fewer than five on-campus Berean Christian classes. Part-time seniors receive lowest priority in class selection and are only placed as space permits after all full-time student schedules have been developed, and consecutive class periods are not always possible and unassigned class periods between classes are not allowed. All students are expected to take courses required for graduation on campus at BCHS; selected other elective courses taken off-campus or independently will receive BCHS credit only with pre-approval. Part-time seniors will be subject to the same application fees, registration fees, and deadlines as described on page 1, and are billed tuition and additional fees as follows:

- Annual tuition for each class taken on campus is % of the total full-time tuition for each on-campus class. The family may elect 10-month, 11-month, or to pay tuition in full, but there is no early pay discount option for payment-in-full of part-time tuition (nor are part-time students eligible for Tuition Assistance, Christian Ministry Discount, or Valedictorian Scholarship programs).
- A \$25 per semester part-time administration fee will be assessed.
- For All School Retreat, part-time students will be subject to an additional fee, prorated by the number of on-campus classes enrolled in: one class \$320; two classes \$240; three classes \$160; four classes \$80.
- Class/lab fees and activity fees apply depending upon course and activity selections, as per page 2.
- Students using BCHS staff for test proctoring of non-BCHS exams will be assessed a fee of \$50 per exam for exams up to 1 hour in duration. If duration exceeds 1 hour, an additional \$25 per ½ hour will be assessed.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND DISCOUNTS

Christian Ministry Discount

Granted upon application to families with a parent employed as a full-time, licensed or ordained Pastor, K-12 Christian School Teacher, or Christian School Administrator. Ministry families may also qualify for need-based tuition assistance. Some ministry positions are subject to household income qualifications.

Tuition Assistance

Granted upon application to financially qualifying families. Main evaluation criteria include family income, family size, and number of students currently enrolled at Berean Christian. Award amounts may also be impacted by timeliness of application, fulfillment of prior years' volunteer hours obligation, and by the number of financially qualifying families sharing the available assistance funds.

Valedictorian Scholarship

Available to 8th grade valedictorians from middle schools in the Bay Area who attend Berean Christian full-time as freshmen. The scholarship is \$500 for the freshman year (prorated across tuition payment plan chosen), automatically renewable in subsequent years at \$500 per year of enrollment if the student remains full-time and maintains a 3.75 BCHS GPA or above. An application is not required, but the family must arrange for the middle school office to send a letter to Berean Christian acknowledging the student's valedictorian qualification by **August 31st** of freshman year (not applicable to valedictorians who are transfer students entering after 9th grade).

General

BCHS does not award multi-student tuition discounts (however, the number of students currently enrolled at BCHS is a criterion considered for families who complete an application for need-based tuition assistance).

BCHS financial assistance programs above are available to **full-time students only** (defined as enrollment in five or more on-campus BCHS classes), and only apply to the tuition portion of a family's obligation. Funds are limited; apply by **April 1st** or earlier for priority consideration. Awards are granted for one school year. **Families with continuing need must reapply each year.**

For need-based awards, BCHS uses an outside agency to collect application information and to provide preliminary assessment, but the Berean Christian Board Finance Committee makes the final decisions about award eligibility and amounts. An application fee payable to the agency applies. A federal tax return from the most recent calendar year is required as part of the application, and thus families seeking assistance are advised to file tax returns as early as possible. FINANCIAL POLICIES

General

- Berean Christian uses a tuition management service, FACTS, to invoice and receive payments. A \$40 late fee will be
 assessed each month when the total account past due balance tuition and/or fees exceeds \$250.
- Monthly billing invoices are emailed by default. The incidental fees invoice is separate from the tuition invoice. Families
 are responsible to know and pay their monthly tuition and fee obligations on time even when they cannot locate their
 invoices. Families are expected either to enroll in automatic recurring payments or establish online access to their
 billing account so they can review and pay account balances on time.
- Payment by recurring automatic electronic fund transfer (EFT) from bank accounts is available at no charge, and EFT
 enrollment is highly encouraged to ensure timely payment. Personal checks, bank bill-pay checks, cash, cashier's
 checks, and money orders are also acceptable in the school office.
- Automatic recurring, as well as one-time, online payment by credit and debit cards are available options, but card processing fees (approximately 3%) are passed on to the payer, increasing the total amount paid versus billed.
- Returned checks and failed EFT transactions will result in a \$30 fee charged to the family account and the \$40 late fee will also be assessed if the failed payment results in a past due balance exceeding \$250.
- Students with accounts more than two months delinquent at semester break will not be allowed to return second semester until the balance is brought into compliance.
- Report cards and diplomas of students with outstanding balances at year end will be withheld until the balance due is
 paid in full.
- Seniors whose accounts have a past due balance due on May 1st will be restricted from participating in commencement ceremonies.
- Returning students may not begin the next school year and may forfeit their enrollment to a waitlisted student if the prior year's balance is not paid in full by July 31st.
- Accounts with a history of recurrent delinquencies may be subject to more stringent, customized terms as a condition of
 continued Berean Christian enrollment.

Refunds and Withdrawals/Partial-Year Enrollment

- All application, registration, class, and activity fees are non-refundable once billed, unless billed in error.
- For partial year enrollment, the first two quarters of enrollment are weighted at 5/9 of the annual tuition due. Depending upon the payment plan and monthly tuition due date that the family elected, as well as the date of withdrawal, **additional tuition may be due even if monthly tuition payments have been kept current.** Monthly tuition payment plans offered have been divided evenly as a convenience to families, but actual tuition obligation is based on the student's total days of BCHS enrollment. When tuition has been prepaid in part or in full, a partial tuition refund may be issued upon withdrawal. A detailed explanation of how prorated tuition has been calculated, based on the total days of enrollment, will be provided at the time of withdrawal, explaining any amount due or refunded.
